The SDG Gender Index covers 144 countries, 98% of the world's girls and women, and 14 of 17 Sustainable Development Goals. It includes 56 indicators capturing gender-related measures across the 2030 Agenda.

Best

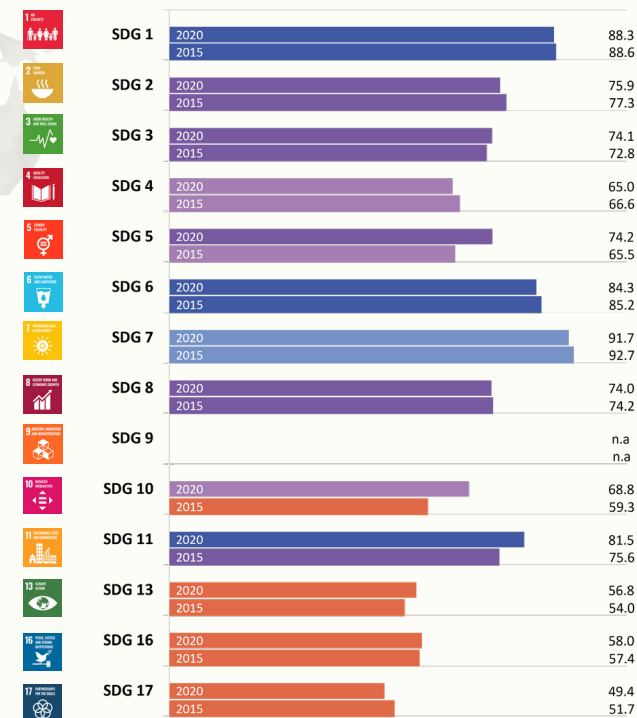
- Extent to which laws criminalise, protect or recognise sexual orientation and same-sex conducts
- Proportion of ministerial/senior government positions held by women
- Proportion of the urban population living in slum

Worst

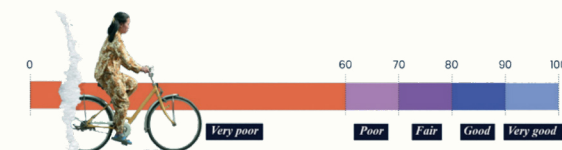
- Tax revenue as a percentage of GDP
- Proportion of women (15+ years) who report they are satisfied with efforts to preserve the environment
- Proportion of women in science and technology research positions

Scoring system



- Fast progress:** Increase by >3 points
- Some progress:** Increased by <3 points and >1 point
- No progress:** Less than +1 or -1 change in points
- Decline or Wrong direction:** Decline by more than -1 point
