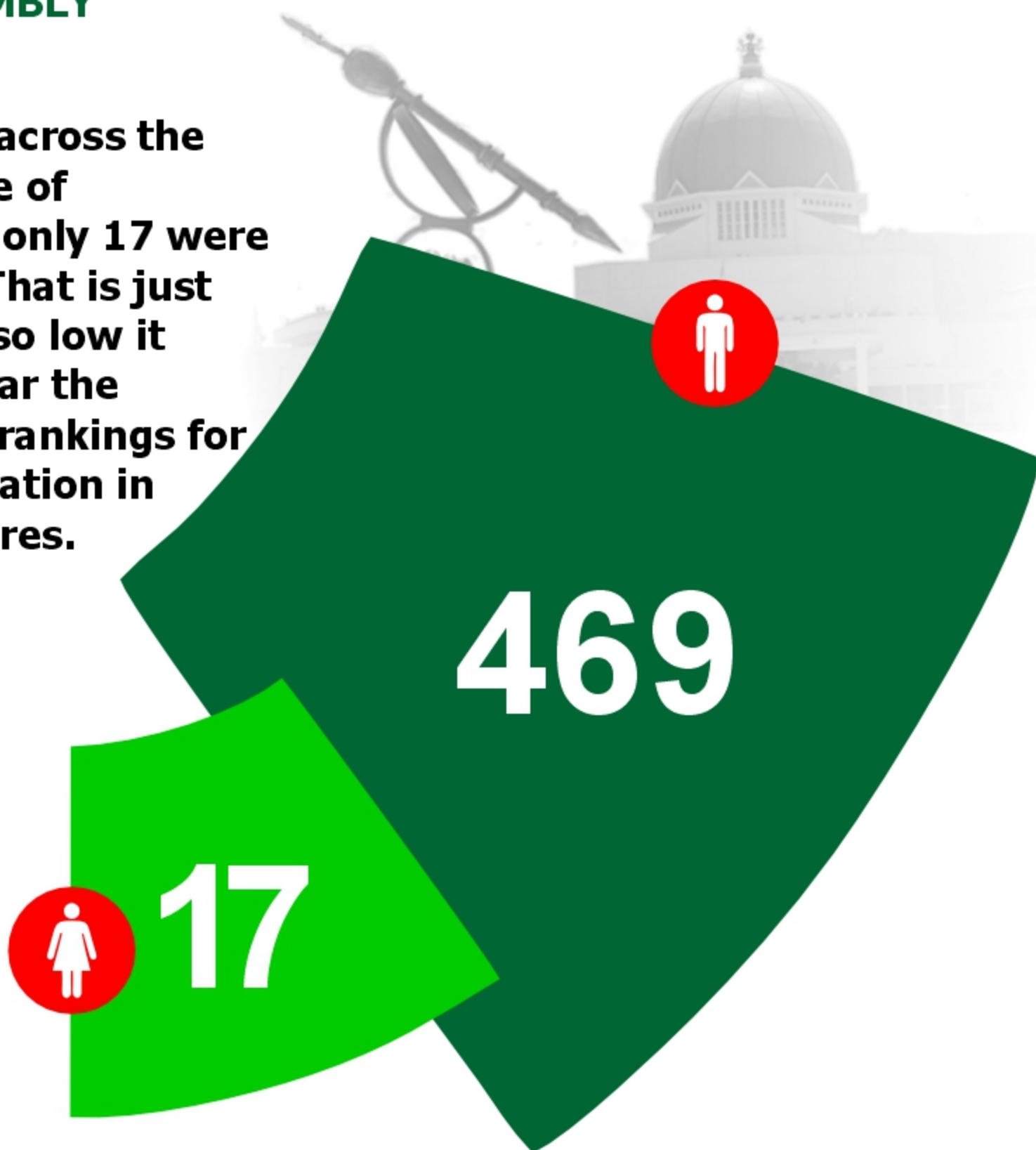


WOMEN'S REPRESENTATION IN NIGERIA NATIONAL ASSEMBLY

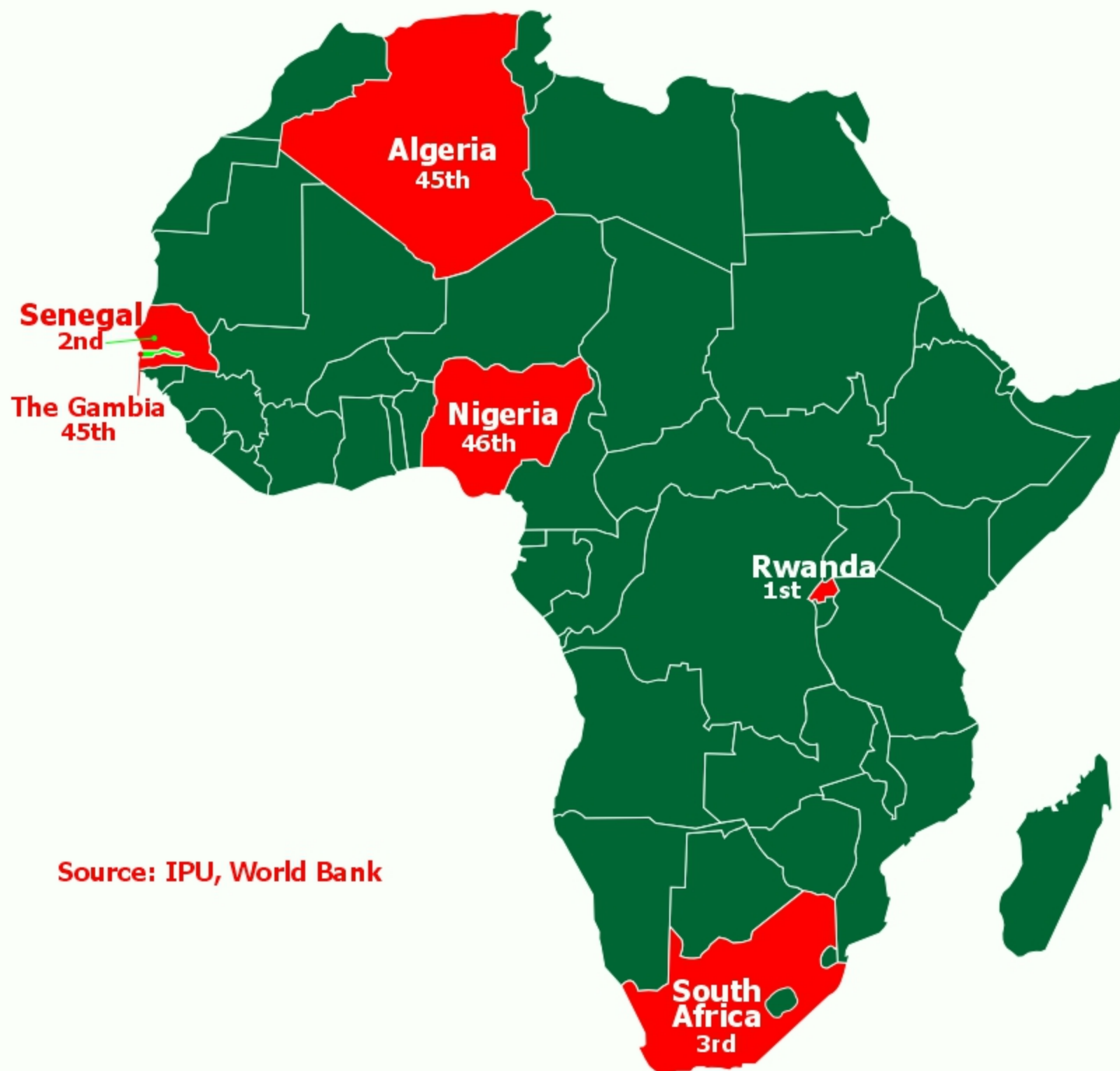
Out of 469 seats across the Senate and House of Representatives, only 17 were won by women. That is just 4.2%, a number so low it places Nigeria near the bottom of global rankings for gender representation in national legislatures.
