

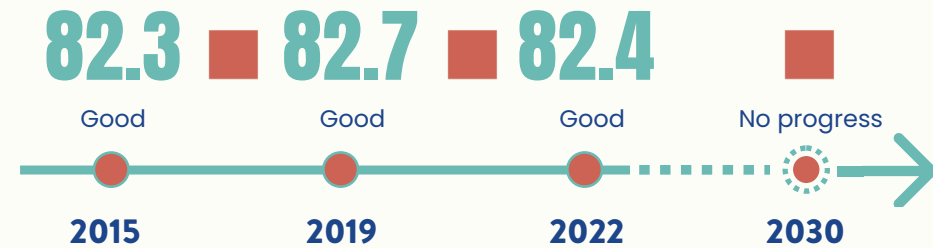

If past trends continue, the world won't achieve gender equality until 2121. How is Canada performing on gender equality in the SDGs?

The 2024 SDG Gender Index covers 139 countries, 96% of the world's girls and women, and 14 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals. It includes 56 indicators capturing gender-related measures across the 2030 Agenda.

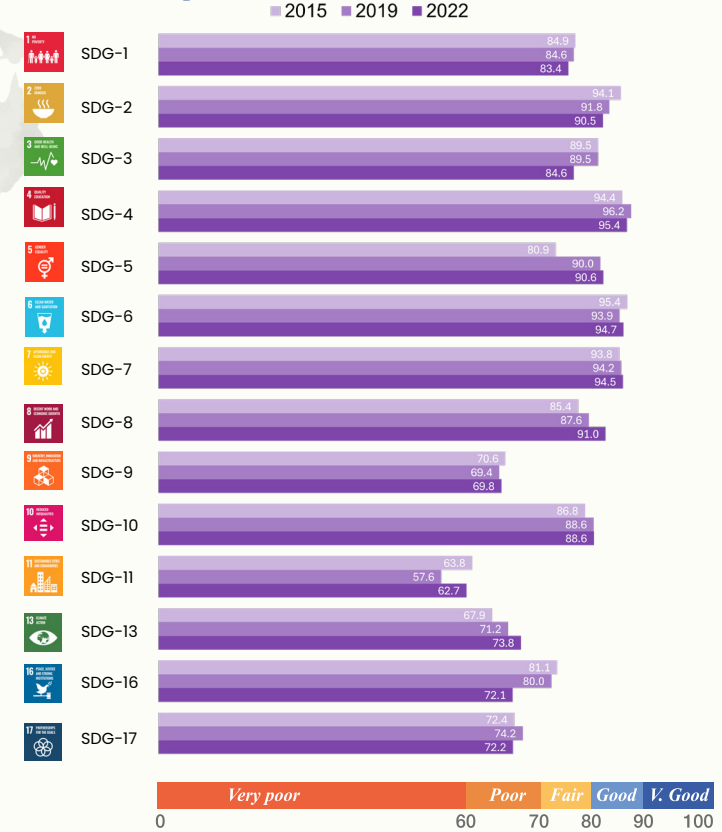
Index Score



Based on past trends, no country will achieve gender equality by 2030. To achieve a score of 100 in 2030, Canada would need to improve by 2.2 points per year from 2022.

Best and Worst Performing Indicators Since 2015

Best

- Ind. 5.5: Proportion of ministerial/senior government positions held by women
- Ind. 13.1: Extent to which the delegation representing the country at the COP meeting is gender balanced
- Ind. 10.1: Palma inequality ratio, the share of income of the richest 10% of the population divided by the share of income of the poorest 40%

Worst

- Ind. 11.2: Greenhouse gas emissions from the energy sector
- Ind. 11.4: Quality of trade and transport-related infrastructure measured by the logistics performance index
- Ind. 2.4: Proportion of women (15+ years) who reported having enough money to buy food that they or their family needed in the past 12 months

Pace of Change

- Fast progress:** Score increased by more than 0.6 points per year
- Some progress:** Score increased between 0.2 and 0.6 points per year
- No progress:** Score stayed the "same" (margin between -0.2 and +0.2 points per year)
- Decline:** Score declined by more than -0.2 points per year
