If past trends continue, the world won't achieve gender equality until 2121. How is the DR Congo performing on gender equality in the SDGs?

The 2024 SDG Gender Index covers 139 countries, 96% of the world's girls and women, and 14 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals. It includes 56 indicators capturing gender-related measures across the 2030 Agenda.

## Index Score



Based on past trends, no country will achieve gender equality by 2030. To achieve a score of 100 in 2030, DR Congo would need to improve by 7.22 points per year from 2022.





Ind. 1.4: Proportion of women (15+ years) who report feeling comfortable with their household income



# Pace of Change



Fast progress: Score increased by more than 0.6 points per year



Some progress: Score increased between 0.2 and 0.6 points per year
