

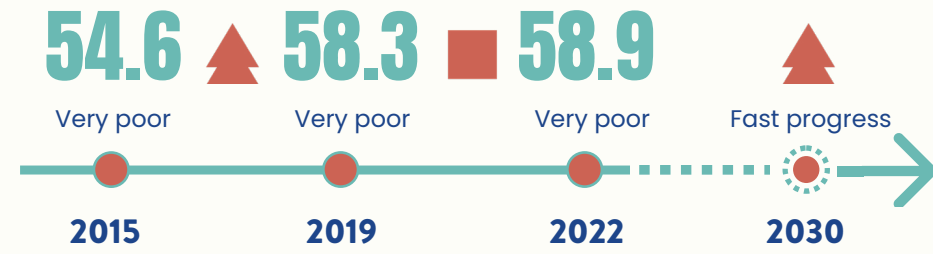

If past trends continue, the world won't achieve gender equality until 2121. How is Ghana performing on gender equality in the SDGs?

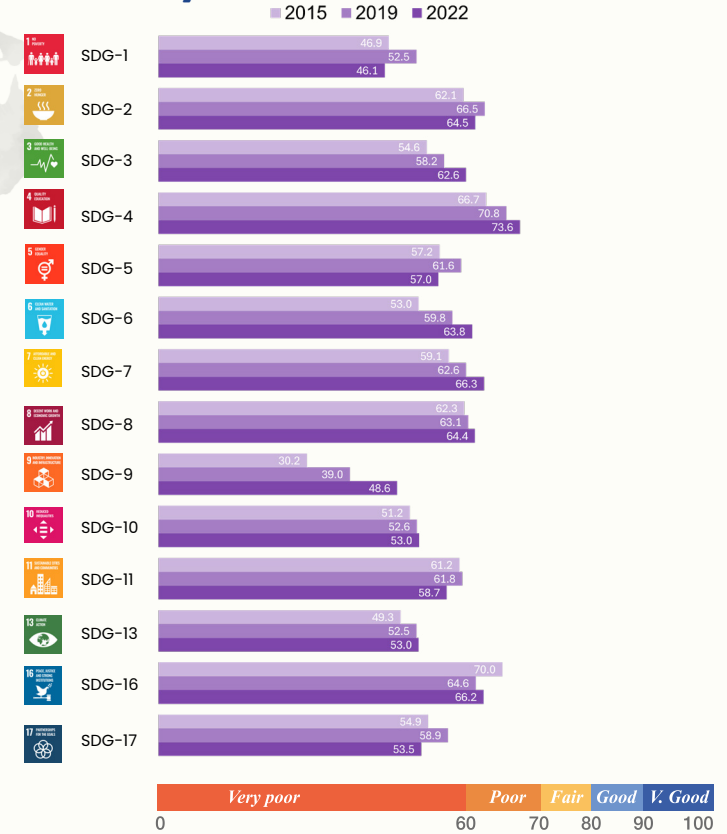
The 2024 SDG Gender Index covers 139 countries, 96% of the world's girls and women, and 14 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals. It includes 56 indicators capturing gender-related measures across the 2030 Agenda.

Index Score



Based on past trends, no country will achieve gender equality by 2030. To achieve a score of 100 in 2030, Ghana would need to improve by 5.14 points per year from 2022.

Best and Worst Performing Indicators Since 2015

Best

- Ind. 1.4: Proportion of women (15+ years) who report feeling comfortable with their household income
- Ind. 9.1: Proportion of women who have made or received digital payments in the past year
- Ind. 5.2: Proportion of women (15+ years) who reported that, if in trouble, they have relatives or friends they can count on to help them

Worst

- Ind. 16.2: Women victims of intentional homicide (per 100,000 female population)
- Ind. 16.3: Proportion of women (15+ years) who report that they feel safe walking alone at night in the city or area where they live
- Ind. 8.1: Wage equality between women and men for similar work

Pace of Change

- Fast progress:** Score increased by more than 0.6 points per year
- Some progress:** Score increased between 0.2 and 0.6 points per year
- No progress:** Score stayed the "same" (margin between -0.2 and +0.2 points per year)
- Decline:** Score declined by more than -0.2 points per year
