If past trends continue, the world won't achieve gender equality until 2121. How is Ghana performing on gender equality in the SDGs?

The 2024 SDG Gender Index covers 139 countries, 96% of the world's girls and women, and 14 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals. It includes 56 indicators capturing gender-related measures across the 2030 Agenda.

### Index Score



Based on past trends, no country will achieve gender equality by 2030. To achieve a score of 100 in 2030, Ghana would need to improve by 5.14 points per year from 2022.

Ind. 5.2: Proportion of women (15+ years) who reported that, if in trouble, they have relatives or friends they can count on to help them




Ind. 16.2: Women victims of intentional homicide (per 100,000 female population)

Ind. 16.3: Proportion of women (15+ years) who report that they feel safe walking alone at night in the city or area where they live


