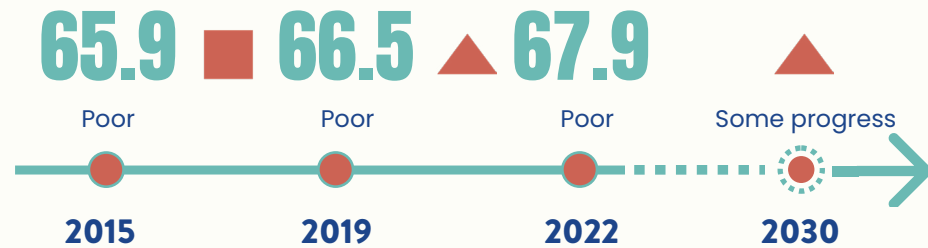


Asia and the Pacific

If past trends continue, the world won't achieve gender equality until 2121. How is Kyrgyzstan performing on gender equality in the SDGs?

The 2024 SDG Gender Index covers 139 countries, 96% of the world's girls and women, and 14 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals. It includes 56 indicators capturing gender-related measures across the 2030 Agenda.

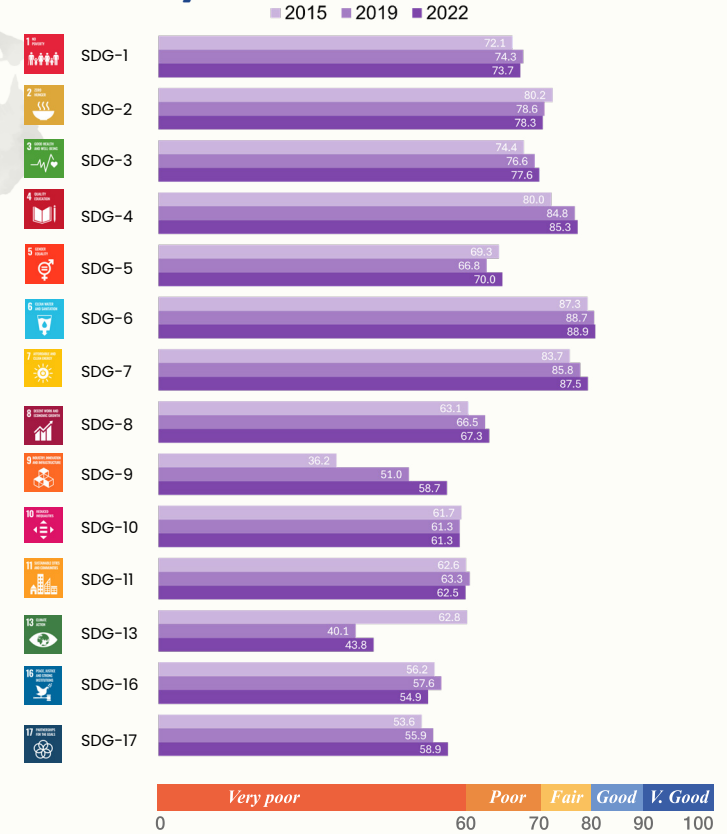
Index Score



Based on past trends, no country will achieve gender equality by 2030. To achieve a score of 100 in 2030, Kyrgyzstan would need to improve by 4.01 points per year from 2022.

Best and Worst Performing Indicators Since 2015

Best ↑

- Ind. 4.1: Proportion of girls (a year before official primary school age) who are enrolled in pre-primary education
- Ind. 8.5: Proportion of women who hold a bank account at a financial institution
- Ind. 9.1: Proportion of women who have made or received digital payments in the past year

Worst ↓

- Ind. 13.1: Extent to which the delegation representing the country at the COP meeting is gender balanced
- Ind. 5.5: Proportion of ministerial/senior government positions held by women
- Ind. 5.1: Proportion of young women (aged 15-19 years) who have been married

Pace of Change

- ▲ **Fast progress:** Score increased by more than 0.6 points per year
- ▲ **Some progress:** Score increased between 0.2 and 0.6 points per year
- **No progress:** Score stayed the "same" (margin between -0.2 and +0.2 points per year)
- ▼ **Decline:** Score declined by more than -0.2 points per year
