The 2024 SDG Gender Index covers 139 countries, 96% of the world's girls and women, and 14 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals. It includes 56 indicators capturing gender-related measures across the 2030 Agenda.

Based on past trends, no country will achieve gender equality by 2030. To achieve a score of 100 in 2030, Nepal would need to improve by 4.84 points per year from 2022.

Some progress: Score increased between 0.2 and 0.6 points per year




No progress: Score stayed the "same" (margin between -0.2 and +0.2 points per year)




Decline: Score declined by more than -0.2 points per year
