



#### Sub-Saharan Africa

If past trends continue, the world won't achieve gender equality until 2121. How is Togo performing on gender equality in the SDGs?

The 2024 SDG Gender Index covers 139 countries, 96% of the world's girls and women, and 14 of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals. It includes 56 indicators capturing gender-related measures across the 2030 Agenda.

### Index Score



Based on past trends, no country will achieve gender equality by 2030. To achieve a score of 100 in 2030, Togo would need to improve by 6.33 points per year from 2022.






